Second Annual Celts and Currachs festival will celebrate Celtic heritage with food, music, dance, crafts and currach race exhibitions on Saturday August 25th from 10am-7pm.

Entertainment includes Danny O' Flaherty and the Makem and Spain Brothers!

Currachs have been used for fishing and racing in the Celtic region for over six thousand years! Only five boat-smiths continue to build boats in Ireland! These traditional Irish workingman's boats are constructed of wood, tar and canvas and measure 23-25 ft. long and 3 ft. wide.

Handling of these boats can be learned right here in New London and exhibitional races will be held on Sat. Aug. 25th!
